Way into our discussion and my normal questions and answers techniques, I had to tease him with some questions which could be termed simple. “Who are you and what

are you on earth to accomplish?” was my question. I felt that expression of someone trying to say, “My name is.... And I am a student of...”

If truth is to be told today, most young people do not have an inkling of who they are. Hence, they can’t live their God-Life on daily basis. They can’t make that impact because they are still not in their own path in life and they are not just in the right environment to help them unleash that awesome potentials they carry.

Purpose Discovery



The greatest tragedy on the planet earth is not **death**. It is neither **a life without purpose**. The greatest tragedy that can happen to mankind is **a life without the discovery of purpose**.

Have you ever thought of it this way? Have you?

You see, “when the purpose of a thing is not **known**, abuse is inevitable” {Dr. Myles Munroe} and that is where discovery which is significant comes in.

No one is finished when death calls. Do you know why? It has been a conventional knowledge that one day a

man must journey to the great beyond. It is already an established fact and cannot be disputed.

Hence everyone is prepared to die either today or tomorrow. Irrespective of when the call of {the physical} death arrives and when a person is willing to answer the call, what really makes sense is that one day one must have to answer the call to eternity.

You see, the greatest tragedy in life is not a **life without a purpose** because the purpose of a man is not determined by the man himself. Hence, he depends on the **manufacturer** {according to Dr. Myles Munroe} to **know** his purpose. A product can never determine its **Purpose**. It has not the potential to say **i am for...** and **I must...** it is rather the original intent of the **producer** which has already been conceived and fashioned in his mind that comes to play when the creation is been put to place. For instance, the producers of kitchen pots are always aware of the purpose of their products before they even set out to start the production. The purpose of each pot affects its **size** and **structure** and of course the **materials** to be used in its production.

Therefore, to lay further credence to my assertion above, we ought to understand that a man's purpose is known by God before his creation {Biblical Ref: **Jer.**

1:5}. We can never be **without purpose**. We only **discover** that which we've been imbibed with from creation.

To Discover

Often times we have asked questions and bother our heads trying to know what it all entails that we discover our purpose. Answers to those troubling and brain-wracking questions may not be reached easily if we do not understand the bases of what discovery {to discover} means independently.

Having viewed the word “discover” over the years, I have come a conclusion as the below:

To discover is to remove a cover: The word “discover” is synonymous to words like “**uncover**” and “**unveil**”. And below are the denotative meanings of them all:

Uncover: To reveal the Identity of...

Unveil: To remove a veil from...

Discover: To remove the cover from...

Yearningly, you will find out the similarities. They all have something in common which is geared at making

sure that one will be able to see clearly. **To reveal the identity of** something means that that thing has an identity **but hidden**. **To remove a veil** from something connotes that beauty lies within the **veil but is hidden under the veil**. **And to discover** is to remove a cover {refer to uncover above}.

The Best is in YOU already.

Most young people have failed to find out that the **best** they can be is resident in their Purpose and their Purpose is **resident** in their **discovery** through **knowledge**. If it is covered, it is then in you but need an uncovering.

THREE TRIPODS OF DISCOVERY

Discovery Determines Destination (D³).

Anyone who is set to go on a journey first discovers {finds out} his route before he takes off. And the right **routes** take the person to the right destination. This is to say that if discovery of purpose has not taken place, then it is impossible for one to get the already proposed destination by his maker. A destination may be reached but not all destinations are destined for everyone. This is to say that without discovery of purpose, man derails away from his own place.

Discovery Determines Delivery (D³).

In one of the platform I had the privilege to speak on in 2017, I threw a question to the young people in that forum: Have you ever seen a woman who delivered {gave birth to a child} without having discovered that she was pregnant? Their response, you should know by now, was No! I have never seen something like that and I doubt if you have.

Whenever a woman conceives, there is always a discovery of the new state of being of the personality. This manifest in the systematic change of body structure and absence of the “conventionally normal” for every woman –stoppage of the monthly flow for the next nine months {till delivery} is one significant evidence and that alone leads to discovery.

At this point, when the discovery has been made, the woman concerned becomes conscious of certain things, bearing in mind that she now carries another human being who deserves to live. Therefore she takes care of her health and that of the fetus. She keeps to prescribed medications, attends ante-natal programmes, eats

prescribed foods and desists from any harmful adventure that could cause miscarriage or harm of any kind. **(We shall discuss those harmful adventures that could cause one to derail from purposeful living at the end of this chapter.)**

At this time also, the woman is expectant. Her husband is expectant. Her family and that of her husband are expectant. Most importantly and most fascinatingly, the people around her {of whom she has no relationship} are expectant too; I mean the people of whom the child is born. The people of whom the expected child will become a messiah to are also ready to welcome him to their world.

Upon nine months after conception {time for nurturing of purpose and building up}, the woman sets into labour –pain is also involved when necessary. After the labour, comes the delivery which is preceded by the joyful sound.

Now, do this assignment: **Liken yourself to the pregnant woman.**

Discovery Determines Value (DDV).

The value you place on yourself and others is solely dependent on the discoveries you've made. Chief amongst those discoveries is the discovery of Purpose – YOUR WHYs.

How to Discover Your Purpose

This is perhaps the most fascinating or should I say the most anticipated part of this chapter. I bet you, you expected it.

To so many people –young and old– getting to their own place on the earth has been of a chronic-effect problem. They do not know their left from their right. Hence, they imitate what others do in their own place.

This, to a large extent has caused so many people a life of misery and unfulfillment.

In the remaining part of this chapter we shall discuss extensively on how one can discover one's WHY in life. This, I shall do through three different yardsticks for

effective purpose discovery. I hope you pay attention to them:

1. THE FIVE MOVEMENT QUESTIONS:

- i. What are you passionate about?** That particular thing that consumes your passion on daily basis could be an indication to what solution you bring to the earth.
- ii. What can you do without being paid?** If money isn't involved, that thing you will still do and do better with all your strengths could be your place of assignment.
- iii. What can you do all your life without getting weary?** That thing you can stay on for a very long time without getting wearied or complain could be a road to your purpose.
- iv. What is it that puts tears in your eyes?** Whether tears of joy or sadness, that situation that forces tear to drop from your eyes could either be a situation you are to remedy or a happenstance you are born to encourage.

- v. **What moves you to action?** What is that issue that can't allow you sit down, fold your arms and watch in peace? It should be put to a check. That thing that cannot permission to be idle for a moment could be your purpose.

2. SIGNPOSTS TO YOUR ASSIGNMENTS (Dr. Mike Murdock)

- **What you love is a clue to the gifts and wisdom you contain to complete your assignment.**
- **What you hate is a clue to something you are assigned to correct.**
- **What grieves you is a clue to something you are assigned to heal.**

3. CONNECT TO THE MANUFACTURER (SOURCE)

This is obviously the most important step in **purpose discovery**. To every product, there is an original intent and that intent has for long been the intention of the Manufacturer even before the product becomes a reality. Hence the manufacturer knows not just the **WHYS** of a product but also the **HOWs**. The producer knows all the uses of the product and how best a customer could

maximize the usage and gain satisfaction from the product. This makes the manufacturer not only responsible for manufacturing the product but also keeps him in a position to attend to customers' questions and clear their confusions in due time.

God is the manufacturer and we are the products he has made in his own image with purposes to each one and he knows everything about us and how we can maximize our lives. Therefore, it is important to note that connecting and working with the creator gives you the opportunities and an undying privilege to have the first-hand information about yourself.

GOD IS ALWAYS IN THE CENTER OF THE EQUATION OF ANY LIFE OF PURPOSE

To connect to the creator, you must:

- **Have a working relationship with God:** This starts at the point when someone intentionally hands over his life to the lordship of God through Jesus Christ.
- **Strengthening the relationship:** Consistency in connection with God makes the difference in most cases. He is not just the manufacturer; he is also

your father and can be related with as thus. Hence, in a working relationship with God, the **Koinonia** is always strengthened **in the place of prayers, the word of God, Fellowship of brethren and Evangelism.**

- **Free from bounds:** Purpose discovery can be achieved free from any bound when we connect to the creator of our purpose. In him we live, more and have our being. **In him we have our Purpose.** Do you know the most fascinating thing about him? We are free to reach, connect and relate with him in a very free manner because he is our father.
- **Study the Manufacturers guide/manual:** The manufacturer guide to all humanity (the bible) is available for all mankind to always look into in order to find direction and strength for the journey as well. This manual is available at relatively no cost. Therefore it is the duty of man to take a glance and discover his own bit from the book which has been given.

Harmful Adventures that aborts Purposefulness

It is pertinent that we take concise look into those salient factors that could cause one to either derail from his purpose or miscarry his potentials. These adventures are not healthy at all and any young person who cleaves to any of them may not see himself in the right place.

Wrong Association:

I may not write much about this here because I took time to discuss it extensively in one of the chapters of our newest book (25 Top Secrets for Every Youth) but I must remind you that the circle of friends you keep determines what shape your life will take, now and tomorrow. The purpose of a man is tramped when in the wrong company.

When I discovered this in school, my life changed entirely. I started having a very few friends who were conscious of who they are and where they are going. I made friends who have passion for building up themselves and becoming purposefully different in their lives.

You can never operate above the circle of friends you keep. You can only move at the same pace with your associates. Hence, in building up yourself for a purposeful life, it is very important that we do away with the negative kind of **PEERS** which means {according to Dr. Benjamin Carson} **People {who} Encourage Errors, Rudeness {and} Stupidity**. These kinds of people won't allow you to get the “**Big Picture Mentality**”. They will never.

Unnecessary Emulation/Comparison:

This is one of the killers of purpose every young person must avoid. When you've taken time to go through the process of discovery of your purpose, it is also important that you understand that your purpose or assignment is not exactly the same as that of the other person by your side. Hence, undue comparison isn't important at all.

Never allow the success of others to become a threat to you. It has taken so many young people out of their purpose and crumbled on the way to the top.

If your why is to bless people and minister salvation through songs, for instance, please do not drag the podium with that person whom God has assigned to be there probably because you see him wearing good suit.

Work on being the best in your own place.

Undue Pressure:

So many young people put themselves under pressure because they want to perform better than the other person and become noticed more than others. Mehn! That's not your purpose. You are **YOU** and cannot afford to be another person.

In as much as I am not in support of complacency, I do not subscribe to the notion that one must be put under unnecessary pressure to become like another person and behave or achieve the same result.

Undue pressure makes some young persons to start doubting whether they saw their vision clearer and whether they have actually discovered their purpose.

This is one of the most effective killers of destiny and a disrupter of purpose. Learn not to put out things that are supposed to be done today for tomorrow. It is a little fox that might not be given an attention now but they sure have a way of destroying the vine.

In developing yourself in order to align with your divine purpose and die empty, do everything you need to do promptly. Start the course and start it now. Enroll for coaching and start it now. Read those books and read them now. Everything that you ought to do now should be done promptly.

I must inform you that almost all you have read and will still read in this book will spur you to action. They will motivate you to start developing yourself and start it now.

Learn from Others

In conclusion, it is important to note that in being ourselves and not imitating others nor comparing our achievements with that of others but tenaciously walking in our own lane, we approach the graveyard with nothing left to enrich it.
